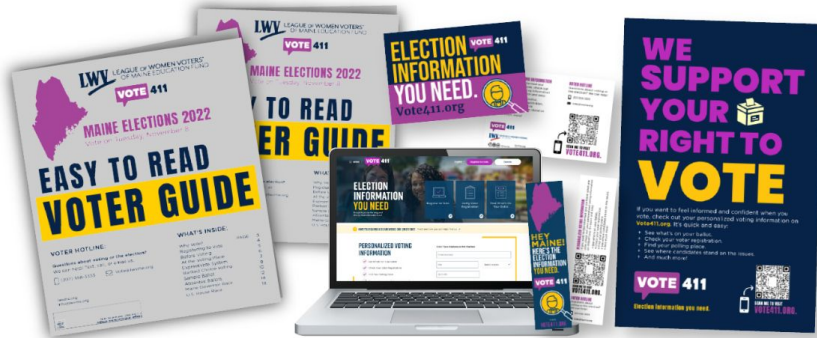
Volunteer with our tabling committee in the Portland area to attend public events and help register voters.

Now through late-September. Research local ballot information and submit to us through a form to be uploaded to Vote411. 50 volunteers needed.

Neighbor-to-Neighbor Canvassing

October. 4-hour canvass at one housing complex in your community to reach voters in Maine's lowest turnout districts. 60 volunteers needed.

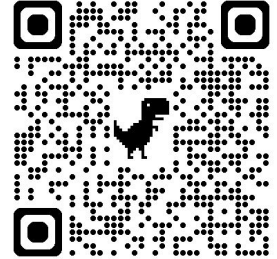
